### **National Anthems and Flags**

Member Federations are requested to review them, and if there have been any changes to the anthem or flag, contact <u>registration@worldrowing.com</u>. If no comments are received by 31 March 2025, World Rowing will assume the files are correct and will use them for all 2025 season events.

#### **Team Uniforms and Blade Designs**

Member Federations are requested to send their National Team Uniforms to World Rowing to <u>prateek.gumbar@worldrowing.com</u> for approval (Art.13). The designs must clearly show the front, back and side of the uniforms and the dimensions (in cm2) of all logos and identifications on the uniforms must be provided. If your team will have different uniforms for U19, U23 or Senior World Championships, each of those uniforms must be submitted for prior approval. It is reminded that all crews (including para crews) of a National Team must wear the same uniform at any particular regatta.

# 4. World Rowing Indoor Championships (WRICH) – IMPORTANT UPDATES – ENTRY PROCESS

Following requests by several member federations, the following adjustments have been made to the entry procedure for the WRICH. Please distribute to your Indoor Rowing and broader rowing communities.

- Early entries. Times recorded at National Indoor Championships events held from 1<sup>st</sup> October 2024 – will now be able to use that time to enter in the 2025 WRICH. This is an extension of several weeks prior to the opening of the registration period. Likewise, all 3 options to register and enter a valid score – will also be valid. See <u>here</u> for event details.
- Closing date. The closing date for entries has been extended until 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2025 at 12:00hrsCET. All 3 options to register and enter a valid score remain possible.
- Developing Nations entry fee. WR will provide access to a developing nation entry fee to targeted Member Federations with the greatest needs. Relevant Member Federations will be contacted on 20th Jan. For more information, please contact <u>development@worldrowing.com</u>
- Developing Nations. Competitors who participated in an official World Rowing (WR) Development programme camp or other official WR activities will be able to use valid scores performed in any testing activities to enter the WRICH – provided they occur between the 1<sup>st</sup> October 2024 and 3<sup>rd</sup> February 2025.
