Conditions:

The Rowing Regatta will take place on Brno lake on a 2000 m, 6 lane course, equipped with the ALBANO system and fixed start line. The races will be run in accordance with FISA rules (juniors) and Czech Rowing Association (Juniors B).

Olympic Hopes

Regatta starts Friday from 3 pm. It is open for athletes from Slovakia, Poland, Hungary and the Czech Republic. More detailed programme and conditions of races will be delivered to all participating countries by the end of February 2005.

ECEC

The regatta is opened to all rowing association and federations interested to participate.

In the entry the crew representing the association / federation shall be clearly specified.

The ECEC was organised last year by Hungarian Rowing association and the organisers of Brno Regatta would like to uphold the tradition.

Evaluation of the cup - punctual 7 - 5 - 4 - 3 - 2 - 1.

Accommodation:

- **Category A:** Double-room and apartments including bath, WC, TV. Bar, sauna and also physiotherapy are available. *Price €49 / night*
